Industrial Gases Expo embraces 'One Belt, One Road'

China and ASEAN are two of the most important economies in the world that IG Asia 2020 will bring to Bangkok huge opportunities for regional cooperation in an international platform for industrial gases.

In recent years, due to the sustained economic growth and relatively open foreign trade policies of the two sides, the economic and trade relations between ASEAN and China has been continuously strengthened. In 2019 ASEAN has overtaken the United States as China's second largest trading partner and China has remained the largest trading partner of ASEAN for the tenth year in a row.



In recent years, with the development of "One Belt, One Road" Initiative, the economic and bilateral trade between China and ASEAN continues to grow, with China-ASEAN import and export trade worth US \$291.85 billion from January to June 2019, up 4.2 per cent from a year earlier, according to statistics released by China's Ministry of Commerce. At the same time, bilateral investment cooperation has been fruitful. By the end of 2018, the cumulative two-way investment between China and ASEAN had reached 205.71 billion US dollars, and the stock of two-way investment had increased 22 times over the past 15 years. ASEAN has become a key regional market for Chinese enterprises to invest abroad. In addition, economic and trade cooperation between China and ASEAN "One Belt, One Road" Initiative has yielded fruitful results, and the process of regional economic integration has accelerated.
